3. Round the Bay Walk.

The V.R.R.A strongly supports the future development and enhancement of the "Round the Bay Walk", as a means of providing the opportunity for both local community and visitors to our area the benefits of healthy exercise, whilst enjoying the wonderful vista of the iconic Jervis Bay. In addition, the V.R.R.A expresses its sincere concerns at the diminishing views of Jervis Bay, due to the planting and proliferation of unsuitable plant species that have a propensity to become a monoculture. These plants include banksias, acacias, tea trees and sweet pittosporum. We urge the Shoalhaven City Council to redress this situation and opt for a planting regime which controls erosion, is esthetically pleasing, whilst maintaining the vista of the Bay.

4. The VRRR calls on Council to replace shrubs in the Vegetation Plan for Orion Beach Shared Path, with native grasses compatible with the existing area.
