

Collingwood Beach Preservation Group Monthly Report – Feb 2017

1. The Collingwood Beach Dune Vegetation Management Plan “CBDVMP”.

This is work in progress. Next step is meeting between staff, Consultants and Councillors in February 2017.

The final outcome is to be presented to Council by July 2017.

2. Coastal Zone Management Plan “CZMP”

This is work in progress. The CZMP and mapping on Department of Planning site is to be updated for latest Coastal Hazard Mapping.

3. Sea Level Rise Policy “SLR”.

Council resolved at its December meeting to maintain the SLR adopted in 2015.

4. Coastal Hazard Mapping

Presentation by Council to the CCB on 13th Jan reflects significant improvement for the beaches in Jervis Bay.

The results of the revised mapping put on public submission are expected to be presented to Council end of March 2017.

5. Coastal Reforms – Stage 2.

The Department of Planning & OEH responded to the request by the CBPG to make a presentation to the key stakeholders on the South Coast. It was held 16th December.

The reforms are work in progress. The next step awaits resolution of the Minister to be responsible to progress the Coastal Reforms.

6. Beach Monitoring – Survey of dunes

A new survey took place in January – the results reflecting significant growth in sand volume have been sent to Council.
