Membership – Important Facts

To our valued JBCSC Community and Golfers,

It seems there is confusion regarding membership renewal dates and process, and what constitutes eligibility to vote at St Georges Basin Country Club (SGBCC) member meetings.

SGBCC's social membership and golf membership comes up for renewal on 30 June of each year. This is standard practice, and nothing has changed from previous years with SGBCC membership renewals.

Social Membership

Social membership of SGBCC entitles you to vote as a Club member; however, you need to ensure that your social membership is current.

The de-amalgamation process remains active and continues to progress through a complex regulatory pathway. As part of that process, members will ultimately be asked to vote on the future direction of the Club.

Membership ensures your voice can be heard when decisions about the future of the proposed Jervis Bay Community & Sports Club are put to members.

So, we urge current Country Club members to renew their social membership **before 30 June 2026** to ensure you maintain your membership status (and right to vote).

If you are unsure whether your membership is due, check the expiry date on your CC membership card or in The Country Club app. **If your card has a large '2026' on the front, you must renew on or before 30 June** (the fine print on the back of your membership card states this).

If your social membership expires on 30 June 2026, you will not be eligible to vote after that date.

If you choose not to renew your golf membership, please consider retaining your social membership. It can be renewed for 1 or 3 years.

Golf Membership

Your golf membership renewal with the Country Club is also due on 30 June.

This year's golf membership fee is \$460, and the standard 1-month grace period applies (this has been confirmed by SGBCC Management). This means that you **must renew your golf membership by 31 July**. If you do not renew by 31 July, then you are considered non-financial, and you can no longer play golf at either the Basin or Vincentia courses at members' rates.

Jervis Bay Community & Sports Club needs you to renew your golf membership with the Country Club.

The most important thing you can do to ensure the establishment of Jervis Bay Community & Sports Club, and the future of golf at Vincentia, is to renew your membership.

Transition Plan for Golf Membership

On 26 April 2026, JBCSC Board announced that any golfer who renews their Vincentia golf membership through the Country Club this year will have that membership fully recognised by JBCSC upon de-amalgamation, at no additional cost, through to the end of the 2026/2027 membership cycle which concludes 30 June 2027.

In practical terms:

- You remain a full Country Club golfing member with all current rights and privileges.
- Upon de-amalgamation, you will also become a JBCSC golfing member.
- You will not be required to pay additional golf membership fees to JBCSC during that period.

In short, you keep everything you currently have and support the future of golf at Vincentia – all without paying anything extra.

How to Renew?

You can renew your memberships, both social and golf, by:

- Visiting the Country Club front desk at Sanctuary Point and paying in person; OR
- Renewing online through the Country Club Membership Portal

To log in online, you will need your membership number, date of birth and postcode. Once logged in, select 'Renew Membership' and follow the prompts.
