Bicycles Prohibited Signage – Burton Street Mall Vincentia Community Consultation Feedback Received

Thank you for submitting your feedback regarding the above signage changes to Council. We appreciate the time taken by members of the community to contact us with their responses to the proposed changes.

Shoalhaven City Council had received requests relating to the removal of cyclists within Burton Street Mall, Vincentia. The assessment determined that the current layout, low speed environment, and visibility constraints within Burton Street Mall do not support the safe movement of bicycles. To mitigate this issue, it was proposed to implement "Bicycles Prohibited" (R6-10-3) signage restrictions across the full site and from the northern and southern property boundaries.

In response to community feedback, Council will proceed with installing the **G9-58 "Cyclists Dismount"** signage instead, as per *Figure 1*. This sign clearly communicates the requirement for cyclists to dismount while still allowing bicycles to be brought through the mall on foot, aligning with both safety needs and community expectations.
