## CCB

The Community Consultative Body for Vincentia is recognised by the Shoalhaven City Council (SCC) and complies with the Guidelines for the Conduct of Community Consultative Bodies published by the SCC when dealing with Council related matters.

### The CCB objectives are:

- To obtain, on behalf of the local community, information on local government issues relevant to the CCB area or the Shoalhaven City area as a whole.
- To disseminate relevant information to residents and ratepayers within Vincentia.
- To facilitate discussion on, and communicate to Council, the collective views of the community on a range of matters including, but not limited to, Policy Development, land re-zoning, Subdivisions, Development Applications and Works and Services needs of the area.
- To encourage the involvement of residents and ratepayers in Council's decision-making including via the Council Get Involved process at <https://getinvolved.shoalhaven.nsw.gov.au/>

- Council's budget

## VRRRA

### The objectives of the VRRRA include:

- To provide Ratepayers and Residents in Vincentia with a forum to discuss issues of concern.
- To facilitate discussion on issues and communicate the collective views of the community to relevant authorities including local, state or federal government or to other individuals and organisations as appropriate.
- To advocate for improved public facilities in Vincentia and seek grant funding from local, state or federal government to support such facilities.
- To obtain and disseminate information relevant to the Vincentia community.
- To encourage the involvement of the community in the decision-making processes of local, state and federal Governments that impact on Vincentia.
- To support other groups in the Vincentia Community such as the Vincentia Chamber of Commerce with the aim to build a prosperous and sustainable environment by finding common platforms of topics that unite the Vincentia groups, business and the community.
